MASS & MARCH FOR LIFE: Next Sunday, January 21, is the annual Mass and March for Life in Little Rock. Bishop Taylor will celebrate Mass for Life at 12:05 p.m. at the Cathedral of St. Andrew in downtown Little Rock. Each year, this Mass is celebrated to mark the anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton decisions that legalized abortion in the United States. The event is an opportunity for Catholics statewide to come together and pray for an end to abortion. A prayer vigil, in the form of Eucharistic adoration, will be from the evening of Jan. 20 to the morning of Jan. 21 at the Cathedral.

The 40th annual March for Life to the state Capitol will begin at 2 p.m. At the Capitol steps a brief program will be held including prayer and talks from religious and community leaders.

PRE & Mass Attendance: All students registered in PRE should be attending mass weekly. Many of the topics covered include practices and traditions during mass and if students are not attending they will not fully understand the class material. Students that are registered for pre-sacrament or sacrament preparation may miss no more than 2 PRE classes. Attendance is very important in their sacramental preparation. Too many absences will require students to repeat the year and delay their reception of the sacrament. The Diocese of Little Rock requires attendance in sacramental preparation at the parish prior to children receiving their sacraments. Sacramental preparation is a **two-year** program, no exceptions.
