PRE & Mass Attendance: All students registered in PRE should be attending mass weekly. Many of the topics covered include practices and traditions during mass and if students are not attending they will not fully understand the class material. Students that are registered for pre-sacrament or sacrament preparation may miss no more than 2 PRE classes. Attendance is very important in their sacramental preparation. Too many absences will require students to repeat the year and delay their reception of the sacrament. The Diocese of Little Rock requires attendance in sacramental preparation at the parish prior to children receiving their sacraments. Sacramental preparation is a two-year program, no exceptions.
