FIRST COMMUNION SCHEDULE: The Mass schedule for First Communion next weekend is:

3:00 p.m. Saturday—Hispanic Children; Students and parents should arrive 30 minutes before mass.

9:45 a.m. Sunday—English Children; Students and parents should arrive 30 minutes before mass.

15:15 p.m. Sunday—Hispanic Children; Students and parents should arrive 30 minutes before mass.

PRE PARENT MEETING: All current 8TH grade students and parents are required to attend a Confirmation meeting on Sunday, April 29 at 10:45 in church. This meeting outlines the requirements for the student's Confirmation preparation next year. The student's sponsor (one sponsor only) must be a practicing Catholic age 21 or older and be able to meet with the student each week.

Mother's Day Carnations: The Christian Mothers' Society members will be taking orders for carnations the weekends of April 28 & 29 and May 5 & 6. The cost is \$2.50 per carnation. These carnations, honoring mothers, living and deceased, will be used to decorate the Sanctuary on Mother's Day weekend.

PRE ENROLLMENT: All children grades 1 through 12 should be registered in Holy Redeemer's religious education program. Grades 1 and 2 include 1st Reconciliation & 1st Communion preparation. Grades 8 and 9 include Confirmation Preparation. Registration for 2018-2019 continues. **Classes will begin Sunday, September 9, 2018.** Contact Pamela Valencia at pamela.valencia@suddenlinkmail.com or 754-8998 with any questions. All students must register and pay a \$10 registration fee which helps reduce the cost of textbooks for the PRE program. The parish covers the remainder of textbook expense.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES: Parents, please be sure your child attends the remaining 2 PRE classes. For students in pre-sacrament or sacrament preparation it is very important that they attend class each week. Too many absences will require students to repeat the year and delay their reception of the sacrament. The Diocese of Little Rock requires attendance in a 2-year sacramental preparation at the parish prior to children receiving their sacraments.

CINCO DE MAYO: The Hispanic parish members will sponsor the Cinco de Mayo on Saturday, May 5, on the parish grounds. Additional information will be given in future bulletins. Tamales will be made next Saturday, April 21. Volunteers are always appreciated.

RITE OF PEACE: In the United States the exchange of the sign of peace should be done with the shaking of hands. In 2014 the Vatican office for Divine Worship reminded Catholics that a certain restraint should be observed so as to not distract from receiving communion. The peace gesture should be extended by the faithful only to those nearest them—on one's right and left—and that moving about should be avoided.
